


## DART Rate

GOAL: Decrease the DART rate and remain below the benchmark industry average



### LEGEND

**Campus DART Rate** Indicates the DART Rate for Campus. The DART Rate normalizes the total number of DART cases for comparison to benchmark industry rates.

**2022 Industry Average DART Rate** Indicates 2022 Industry Average DART Rate for Colleges, Universities, and Professional Schools benchmark industry rate for comparison.

- Definition: DART Rate normalizes the total number of DART cases per 200,000 hours worked (annual hours equivalent to 100 full-time employees) for comparison to benchmark industry rates.
- Definition: DART Cases are recordable injuries/illnesses that result in day away from work, restricted duty, or job transfer.
- DART cases are a subset of Recordable cases focusing on higher severity injuries/illnesses.
- The 2019 Industry Average DART Rate for Colleges, Universities, and Professional Schools represents the benchmark industry average taken from the Bureau of Labor Statistics.
